For simulation and virtual airline use only. Norse Virtual is a flight-simulation community.



PURPOSE & SCOPE

This policy defines the standards of conduct for all Norse Virtual members so the community remains welcoming, the operation remains credible, and Norse Virtual remains in good standing with the networks and partners it flies with.

It applies to every Norse Virtual member in every venue where they represent the airline: the website, flights flown under Norse Virtual callsigns on any network, the Norse Virtual Discord server, and any public forum where a member identifies as Norse Virtual crew.

P O L I C Y

Norse Virtual is a hobby flown seriously. Members must treat each other, controllers, and the wider flight-simulation community with respect, fly honestly, and protect the airline's name.

COMMUNITY CONDUCT

- Members must treat all members, staff, controllers, and other network users with respect.
- Harassment, discrimination, hate speech, personal attacks, and deliberate hostility are prohibited in all venues.
- Content shared in Norse Virtual venues must be lawful and appropriate for a general audience. Not-safe-for-work content is prohibited.
- Disagreement is welcome; disrespect is not.

NETWORK CONDUCT

- When flying on VATSIM, members must comply with the VATSIM Code of Conduct and Code of Regulations at all times. A VATSIM sanction arising from a flight flown under a Norse Virtual callsign is also a violation of this policy.
- Members must operate to a reasonable standard of realism: file accurate flight plans, follow controller instructions, and disconnect gracefully rather than abandoning an aircraft on a runway or taxiway.
- On VATSIM, members must fly Norse Virtual flights under the airline's registered callsign prefixes only: NBT, UBT, and IGO.

FLIGHT RECORDS & ACCOUNTS

FLIGHT RECORDS

- PIREPs must reflect flights actually flown. Fabricated, duplicated, or padded reports are prohibited.
- Manual PIREPs must include a valid Volanta or VATSIM flight link, per standing dispatch policy.

ACCOUNTS

- One account per person. Accounts must be registered with accurate information.
- Members are responsible for activity on their account.
- Members must be at least 13 years of age.

SOFTWARE

Members must comply with NV-POL-003, the Anti-Software-Piracy Policy. Pirated simulation software has no place in this community.

ENFORCEMENT & AGREEMENT

Norse Virtual is a private community. Membership is a privilege, not a right. Norse Virtual retains the right to suspend or end any membership at any time, for any reason, at its sole discretion and without prior notice. Staff may issue warnings or suspensions where they judge it useful, but nothing in this policy obligates them to do so before removal.

By registering a Norse Virtual account, a member agrees to this policy and acknowledges the at-will nature of membership described above. This policy is reviewed at least annually and when partner requirements change.
